

STOP ILLEGAL EXPORTS OF TOXIC BALTIC SALMON IN THE EU

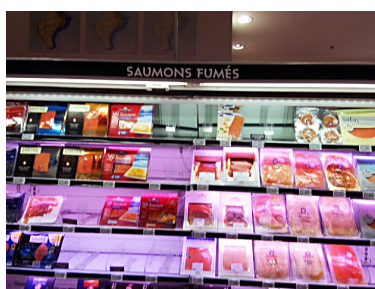
There is evidence that **DIOXIN POISONED BALTIC SALMON** is being illegally marketed in France and Italy.

This problem is not new: in 2013 **MEP ISABELLA LÖVIN** warned the European Commission about tons of Baltic salmon caught by Swedish fishermen and illegally exported to France¹.

The **MARKETING AND SALE** of salmon from the Baltic Sea **IS BANNED** in all EU Member States - with the exception of Sweden, Finland and Latvia - because of the **HIGH LEVELS OF DIOXINS** present in the fish that can have severe negative impacts on human health.

At the same times as illegal sales continue the **EUROPEAN ANGLERS ALLIANCE** has flagged the European Fisheries Control Agency about suspected large-scale **MISREPORTING** of Baltic salmon commercial catches as sea trout².

Despite the EU ban, it is still possible to **BUY TOXIC BALTIC SALMON ONLINE** and no information is provided to the public about safe consumption.



THIS HAS TO STOP! The Commission and the Fisheries Control Agency need to act to protect the health of the EU citizens and the Baltic salmon stocks.
